1SECTION 1. UPDATE TO ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY2INDEX PRODUCTS OF NATIONAL OCEANIC3AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION FOR4GREAT LAKES.

5 (a) UPDATE REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act and not less 7 frequently than once every 7 years thereafter, the Under 8 Secretary for Oceans and Atmosphere shall update the en-9 vironmental sensitivity index products of the National 10 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for each coastal 11 area of the Great Lakes.

12 (b) Environmental Sensitivity Index Product DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term "environmental 13 sensitivity index product" means a map or similar tool 14 that is utilized to identify sensitive shoreline, coastal or 15 16 offshore, resources prior to an oil spill event in order to 17 set baseline priorities for protection and plan cleanup 18 strategies, typically including information relating to 19 shoreline type, biological resources, and human use re-20 sources.

- 21 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
- (1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be
 appropriated to the Under Secretary \$7,500,000 to
 carry out this section.

25 (2) AVAILABILITY.—Amounts appropriated or
26 otherwise made available pursuant to paragraph (1)

shall be available to the Under Secretary for the
 purposes set forth in such paragraph until expended.
