1           (4) CONFIDENTIALITY.—The Commission may  
2 disclose the information in a form which does not  
3 disclose the identity of a specific pharmacy benefit  
4 manager, pharmacy, or health plan for the following  
5 purposes:

6                   (A) To permit the Comptroller General of  
7 the United States to review the information  
8 provided to carry out this Act.

9                   (B) To permit the Director of the Congres-  
10 sional Budget Office to review the information  
11 provided.
