(2) Any correlation between public or private school bus fleet operators whose vehicles are involved. in major accident, and each of the following:

(A) A failure by those same operators of State or local safety inspections.

(B) The average age or odometer readings of the school buses in the fleets of such operators.

(C) Violations of Federal laws administered by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration; the Department of Transportation, or the National Labor Relations Board, or of State law equivalents of such laws.
