AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. PETERS

Viz:

- 1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:
- 2 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . FCC BROADBAND DATA COLLECTION REPORT.**
- 3 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Not later than 18 months
- 4 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Commission
- 5 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
- 6 a report on the broadband deployment and subscription
- 7 data collection practices of the Commission.
- 8 (b) **CONSIDERATIONS.**—The report required under
- 9 subsection (a) shall include—

1           (1) a review of the broadband data collected  
2 through the Form 477 process of the Commission,  
3 including for both fixed and mobile broadband;

4           (2) an explanation of how the Commission en-  
5 sures that broadband data submitted through the  
6 Form 477 process is accurate;

7           (3) recommendations, including legislative rec-  
8 ommendations, on how the Commission can improve  
9 the broadband data collection practices of the Com-  
10 mission with respect to both fixed and mobile  
11 broadband; and

12           (4) with respect to any regulatory recommenda-  
13 tions made in the report, a plan for implementing  
14 those recommendations.

15       (c) PUBLIC COMMENT.—The Commission shall pro-  
16 vide notice and an opportunity for public comment on the  
17 report required under subsection (a) in order to solicit rec-  
18 ommendations from those comments on how the Commis-  
19 sion can improve the broadband data collection practices  
20 of the Commission.
