3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Combating Trafficking
5 in Transportation Act".

6 **SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY
7 COMMITTEE ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

8 Section 5 of the Combating Human Trafficking in
9 Commercial Vehicles Act (Public Law 115-99; 131 Stat.
10 2243) is amended—

11 (1) in subsection (b)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “15” and
2 inserting “16”; and

3 (B) in paragraph (2)—

4 (i) in subparagraph (B), by striking
5 “and” at the end;

6 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by striking
7 the period at the end and inserting “;
8 and”; and

9 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(D) State departments of transpor-
12 tation.”; and

13 (2) in subsection (c)—

14 (A) by striking “Not later than” and in-
15 serting the following:

16 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-
17 graph (2), not later than”; and

18 (B) by adding at the end the following:

19 “(2) STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
20 REPRESENTATIVES.—The Secretary shall appoint
21 the member described in subsection (b)(2)(D) by not
22 later than 9 months after the date of enactment of
23 the Combating Trafficking in Transportation Act.”.
