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On page 50, after line 24, add the following:

2 "(g) TRANSPARENCY.—Not later than 60 days after 3 the date that a transaction agreement is made under sub-4 section (a), the Commandant shall make available to the 5 public, in a searchable format on an Internet website of 6 the Coast Guard, information on the transaction agree-7 ment, including an estimate of committed Coast Guard re-8 sources for and the expected benefits to the Coast Guard 9 from the transaction agreement, with appropriate 10 redactions for proprietary, sensitive, or classified informa-11 tion.

2	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than December
3	30 each year through 2025, the Commandant shall
4	submit to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
5	Transportation of the Senate and the Committee on
6	Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of
7	Representatives a report on the use by the Coast
8	Guard of additional transaction authority under sub-
9	section (a) during the fiscal year ending in such

19	"(ii) a description of—

21	"(II) the parties;
22	"(III) the value;
23	"(IV) the extent of the cost shar-
24	ing among Federal Government and
25	non-Federal sources;

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1	"(V) the duration or schedule;

3	"(VI) all milestones;
4	"(iii) an indication whether the trans-
5	action agreement was renewed during such
6	fiscal year;
7	"(iv) the technology areas in which re-
8	search projects were conducted under the
9	transaction agreement;
10	"(v) the extent to which the use of the
11	transaction agreement—
12	"(I) has contributed to a broad-
13	ening of the technology and industrial
14	base available for meeting Coast
15	Guard needs; and
16	"(II) has fostered within that
17	technology and industrial base new re-
18	lationships and practices that support
19	the United States; and
20	"(vi) the total value received by the
21	Federal Government under the transaction
22	agreement during such fiscal year; and
23	"(B) a list of all anticipated reimbursable,
24	nonreimbursable, and funded transaction agree-

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ments under subsection (a) during the fiscal
year in which the report is submitted.".
