- 8 which report shall include—
- 9 “(1) the number of complaints received by the
- 10 Commission during the year alleging that a con-
- 11 sumer received a robocall or spoofed call;

1           “(2) the number of citations issued by the Com-  
2 mission pursuant to section 503 during the year to  
3 enforce any law, regulation, or policy relating to a  
4 robocall or spoofed call;

5           “(3) the number of notices of apparent liability  
6 issued by the Commission pursuant to section 503  
7 during the year to enforce any law, regulation, or  
8 policy relating to a robocall or spoofed call; and

9           “(4) for each notice referred to in paragraph  
10 (3)—

11                   “(A) the amount of the proposed forfeiture  
12 penalty involved;

13                   “(B) the person to whom the notice was  
14 issued; and

15                   “(C) the status of the proceeding.”.
