AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. YOUNG Viz:

1 At the appropriate place in title VIII, insert the fol-2 lowing:

3 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. PROHIBITION ON OPERATION, PROCUREMENT,
4 OR CONTRACTING ACTION OF FOREIGN5 MADE UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsections (b) and (c), 7 the Secretary of Transportation is prohibited from enter-8 ing into a contract or awarding a grant for the operation, 9 procurement, or contracting action with respect to any 10 small unmanned aircraft system that is manufactured or 11 assembled by a covered foreign entity.  $2^{\circ}$ 

(b) EXEMPTION.—The restrictions under subsection
 (a) shall not apply if the operation, procurement, or con tracting action is for the purpose of—

4 (1) counter-UAS testing, analysis, or training;
5 or

6 (2) aviation safety testing.

7 (c) WAIVER.—The Secretary of Transportation (or 8 the Secretary's designee) may waive any restrictions under 9 subsection (a) on a case by case basis by certifying, in 10 writing not later than 15 days after exercising such waiv-11 er, to the appropriate committees of Congress that the op-12 eration, procurement, or contracting action is required in 13 the national interest of the United States.

14 (d) Replacement of Certain Unmanned Air-15 Craft Systems.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after 17the date of enactment of this section, the Secretary 18 shall replace any unmanned aircraft system that was 19 manufactured or assembled by a covered foreign en-20tity and that is owned or operated by the Depart-21ment of Transportation as of the date of enactment 22 of this section with an unmanned aircraft system 23manufactured in the United States or an allied 24 country (as that term is defined in section 25 2350f(d)(1) of title 10, United States Code).

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1	(2) FUNDING.—There is authorized to be ap-
2	propriated to the Secretary \$5,000,000 to carry out
3	this subsection.
4	(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this Section:
5	(1) COVERED FOREIGN ENTITY.—The term
6	"covered foreign entity" means an entity that is—
7	(A) included on the Consolidated Screening
8	List or Entity List as designated by the Sec-
9	retary of Commerce;
10	(B) doing business as Da Jiang Innova-
11	tions (also known as "DJI") or any successor
12	company;
13	(C) domiciled in the People's Republic of
14	China or the Russian Federation;
15	(D) subject to influence or control by the
16	government of the People's Republic of China
17	or the Russian Federation; or
18	(E) is a subsidiary or affiliate of an entity
19	described in any of subparagraphs (A) through
20	(D).
21	(2) SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT; UNMANNED
22	AIRCRAFT SYSTEM.—The terms "small unmanned
23	aircraft" and "unmanned aircraft system" have the
24	meaning given such terms in section 44801 of title
25	49, United States Code.
