BY STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.—

(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Director, in consultation with the Chairman of the Commission, the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information, the Under Secretary of Commerce for Standards and Technology, the Administrator of General Services, and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, shall submit to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives a report on potential ways to incentivize State and local governments to provide to the Director for inclusion in the database similar information to the information required under subsection (d)(1) regarding covered property owned, leased, or otherwise managed by such governments pursuant to paragraph (1) of this subsection or through other means.

1	(B) Considerations.—The Director, in
2	preparing the report under subparagraph (A),
3	shall—
4	(i) consult with State and local gov-
5	ernments, or their representatives, to iden-
6	tify for inclusion in the report the most
7	cost-effective options for State and local
8	governments to collect and provide the in-
9	formation described in subparagraph (A),
10	including utilizing and leveraging State
11	broadband initiatives and programs; and
12	(ii) make recommendations on ways
13	the Federal Government can assist State
14	and local governments in collecting and
15	providing the information described in sub-
16	paragraph (A).
17	(C) Report update.—Not later than 2
18	years after the date on which the database is
19	established under this section, the Director
20	shall submit to the Committee on Commerce,
21	Science, and Transportation of the Senate and
22	the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the
23	House of Representatives an update to the re-
24	port required under subparagraph (A) that
25	identifies State and local governments that have
