3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.	
4	This Act may be cited as the "CPSC CIO Parity	
5	Act".	
6	SEC. 2. CIO AUTHORITY.	
7	(a) In General.—The Consumer Product Safety	
8	Commission (in this section referred to as the "Commis-	
9	sion") shall ensure that the Chief Information Officer of	
10	the Commission, or other senior information technology	

1	official as designated by the Chairman of the Commission,
2	has a significant role in—
3	(1) the decision-making process for annual and
4	multi-year planning, programming, budgeting, and
5	execution decisions, related reporting requirements,
6	and reports related to information technology;
7	(2) the management, governance, and oversight
8	processes related to information technology; and
9	(3) the hiring of personnel with information
10	technology responsibilities.
11	(b) CIO Approval.—The Chief Information Officer
12	of the Commission, or the official designated under sub-
13	section (a), in consultation with the Chief Financial Offi-
14	cer of the Commission and budget officials, shall advise
15	on the allocation of amounts appropriated to the Commis-
16	sion for information technology, consistent with the provi-
17	sions of appropriations Λ ets, budget guidelines, and rec-
18	ommendations from the Director of the Office of Manage-
19	ment and Budget.
20	(c) Additional Personnel.—The Chairman of the
21	Commission, in consultation with the Chief Information
22	Officer of the Commission, and subject to the approval
23	of the Commission, shall appoint—
24	(1) a Chief Data Officer to serve at the Asso-
25	ciate Executive Director level; and
