1	(b) REPORT OF THE SECRETARY.—Not later than 1
2	year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
3	shall submit to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
4	Transportation of the Senate and the Committee on
5	Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-
6	resentatives a report on the results of the study, which
7	shall include—
8	(1) an identification of how the Department
9	currently evaluates travel and tourism needs or cri-
10	teria in considering applications for grants under the
11	grant programs of the Department;
12	(2) a description of any actions that the De-
13	partment will take to improve the evaluation of
14	tourism- and travel-related criteria in considering
15	applications for grants under those grant programs;
16	and
17	(3) recommendations as to any statutory or
18	regulatory changes that may be required to enhance
19	the consideration by the Department of travel and
20	tourism needs or criteria in considering applications
21	for grants under those grant programs.
22	(c) GAO ASSESSMENT AND REPORT.—
23	(1) Assessment.—The Comptroller General of
24	the United States shall conduct an assessment of the
25	existing resources of the Department used to con-

1	duct travel- and tourism-related activities, including
2	the consideration of travel and tourism needs or cri-
3	teria in considering applications for grants under the
4	grant programs of the Department, in order to iden-
5	tify—
6	(A) any resources needed by the Depart-
7	ment; and
8	(B) any barriers to carrying out those ac-
9	tivities.
0	(2) Report.—Not later than 18 months after
1	the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller
2	General of the United States shall submit to the
3	Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transpor-
4	tation of the Senate and the Committee on Trans-
5	portation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-
6	resentatives a report on the assessment conducted
7	under paragraph (1), which shall include—
8	(A) recommendations for improving the
9	evaluation and consideration by the Department
20	of travel and tourism with respect to the discre-
21	tionary grant programs of the Department;
22	(B) an assessment of the resources needed
23	to carry out the tourism- and travel-related ac-
24	tivities of the Department;

1		(C) an assessment of any barriers to car-
2		rying out activities relating to travel and tour-
3		ism; and
4		(D) recommendations for improving the
5		ability of the Department to carry out activities
6		relating to travel and tourism, which may in-
7		clude proposed statutory or regulatory changes
8	2	that may be needed to facilitate those activities.
