10 icebreaking capacity on the Great Lakes.

1	(b) Initial Survey and Design Work.—The Com-
2	mandant of the Coast Guard shall commence initial survey
3	and design work associated with the acquisition of a new
4	Coast Guard icebreaker that is at least as capable as the
5	Coast Guard Cutter Mackinaw to enhance icebreaking ca-
6	pacity on the Great Lakes.
7	(c) Acquisition Plan.—Not later than 45 days
8	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Com-
9	mandant shall submit a plan to the Committee on Com-
10	merce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the
11	Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
12	House of Representatives for acquiring an icebreaker de-
13	scribed in subsections (a) and (b). Such plan shall in-
14	clude—
15	(1) the details and schedule of the acquisition
16	activities to be completed; and
17	(2) a description of how the funding for Coast
18	Guard acquisition, construction, and improvements
19	that was appropriated under the Consolidated Ap-
20	propriations Act of 2017 (Public Law 115–31) will

be allocated to support the acquisition activities re-

ferred to in paragraph (1).
