1 At the end of title I, insert the following:

2 **SEC. 118. UNITED STATES MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY'S**
3 **SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND RE-**
4 **SPONSE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS.—The
6 Secretary of Transportation shall ensure that, not later
7 than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
8 the recommendations in the Inspector General of the De-
9 partment of Transportation's report on the effectiveness
10 of the United States Merchant Marine Academy's Sexual

1 Assault Prevention and Response program (mandated
2 under section 3512 of the National Defense Authorization
3 Act for Fiscal Year 2017 (Public Law 114–328; 130 Stat.
4 2786)), are fully implemented.

5 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
6 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation
7 shall submit a report to Congress—

8 (1) confirming that the recommendations de-
9 scribed in subsection (a) have been fully imple-
10 mented, and explaining how those recommendations
11 have been implemented; or

12 (2) if such recommendations have not been fully
13 implemented as of the date of the report, including
14 an explanation of why such recommendations have
15 not been fully implemented and a description of the
16 resources that are needed to fully implement such
17 recommendations.
