3	(a) NATIONAL STEM PARTNERSHIP GRANTS.—The
4	Director of the National Science Foundation may award,
5	through a cross-Directorate process including the Direc-
6	torate for Education and Human Resources and at least
7	one additional Directorate of the Foundation, competitive,
8	merit-reviewed grants to support a national partnership
9	of institutions involved in informal STEM learning.

1	(b) Use of Funds.—Activities supported by grants
