Federal reviews of such projects and the improvement of project delivery associated with
those projects; and
"(B) the effectiveness of the Center in

achieving reduction of permitting time and project delivery time.

8 "(2) PERFORMANCE TARGETS.—Not later than 9 180 days after the date on which the Secretary of 10 Transportation establishes performance measures in 11 accordance with paragraph (1), the Secretary shall 12 establish performance targets relating to each of the 13 measures and standards described in subparagraphs 14 (A) and (B) of paragraph (1).

"(3) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 2 15 16 years after the date of the enactment of the Com-17 prehensive Transportation and Consumer Protection 18 Act of 2015 and biennially thereafter, the Secretary 19 shall submit a report to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate 20 21 and the Committee on Transportation and Infra-22 structure of the House of Representatives that de-23 scribes-
