4 lete Ombudsman may disclose information de-  
5 scribed in subparagraph (A) as necessary to re-  
6 solve or mediate a dispute with the permission  
7 of the parties involved.

11 stances of abuse of amateur athletes, including  
12 emotional, physical, and sexual abuse; and

13 “(B) establish mechanisms that allow for  
14 the reporting and investigation of alleged viola-  
15 tions of such policies and procedures; and”.
