(2) APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.—There is appropriated to the Federal Communications Commission for fiscal year 2024, out of amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$3,080,000,000, to remain available until expended, to carry out section 4 of the Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Act of 2019 (47 U.S.C. 1603).

9 (b) SPECTRUM REAUCTION.—

(1) FCC AUCTION 97 REAUCTION OF CERTAIN 10 LICENSES.—Not later than 1 year after the date of 11 enactment of this Act, the Federal Communications 12 Commission shall initiate a system of competitive 13 bidding under section 309(j) of the Communications 14 Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)) to grant licenses for 15 spectrum in the inventory of the Commission within 16 the bands of frequencies referred to by the Commis-17 sion as the "AWS-3 bands", without regard to 18 whether the authority of the Commission under 19 paragraph (11) of that section has expired. 20

(2) COMPLETION OF REAUCTION.—The Federal
Communications Commission shall complete the system of competitive bidding described in subsection
(a), including receiving payments, processing applications, and granting licenses, without regard to
