5	(a) In General.—The Secretary of the department
6	in which the Coast Guard is operating shall conduct an
7	assessment to determine the resources, including per-
8	sonnel and computing resources, required to—
9	(1) reduce the amount of time necessary to
10	process merchant mariner credentialing applications

- 1 to not more than 2 weeks after the date of receipt;

- 3 (2) develop and maintain an electronic mer-
- 4 chant mariner credentialing application.
- 5 (b) Briefing Required.—Not later than 180 days
- 6 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
- 7 the department in which the Coast Guard is operating
- 8 shall provide a briefing to the Committee on Commerce,
- 9 Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the Com-
- 10 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House
- 11 of Representatives with the results of the assessment re-
- 12 quired under subsection (a).
- 13 (e) Definition.—In this section, the term "mer-
- 14 chant mariner credentialing application" means a
- 15 credentialing application for a merchant mariner license,
- 16 certificate, or document that the Secretary is authorized
- 17 to issue pursuant to title 46, United States Code.
