5 (18) as paragraphs (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13),

19 On page 6, line 9, strike “(viii)” and insert “(ix)”.

20 On page 6, line 11, strike “(ix)” and insert “(x)”.

1 On page 6, line 24, strike “and” after the semicolon.

3 lows through page 7, line 1, and insert the following:
