3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "STB Information Se-

5 curity Improvement Act".

6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Surface Transportation
8 Board (in this section referred to as the "STB") shall de9 velop a timeline and plan to implement the recommenda-

1	tions of the Inspector General of the Department of
2	Transportation in Report No. FI2018002, including im-
3	provements—
4	(1) to identify controls, including risk manage-
5	ment, weakness remediation, and security authoriza-
6	tion;
7	(2) to protect controls, including configuration
8	management, user identity and access management,
9	and security training;
10	(3) to detect controls, including continuous
11	monitoring;
12	(4) to respond controls, including incident han-
13	dling and reporting;
14	(5) to recover controls for contingency planning;
15	and
16	(6) to such other tools that would implement
17	the recommendations in the report.
18	(b) Implementation.—
19	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
20	after the date of enactment of this Act, the STB
21	shall submit the plan and timeline developed under
22	subsection (a) to the Committee on Commerce,
23	Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the
24	Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of
25	the House of Representatives.

(2) REPORT.—The STB shall report annually
 to such Committees on the progress on implementa tion of the recommendations until the implementa tion is complete.

5 (3) PLAN IMPLEMENTATION.—The STB shall
6 designate an individual to implement the plan devel7 oped under subsection (a).

8 SEC. 3. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.

9 No additional funds are authorized to carry out the
10 requirements of this Act. Such requirements shall be car11 ried out using amounts otherwise authorized.
